• The draw has been circulated to all clubs and posted on the website		
<ul> <li>Player Photos on Play Cricket</li> <li>Additional settings have now been included within Play Cricket. Previously we had to insert a photo or image for all League Registered Players</li> </ul>		
• There is now a new setting (which we have adopted) where photos will only be required for players aged 18 and over.		
• Process – As a result of the change, there are approximately 300 registration records where the photo or image needs deleting for players under 18 years of age. I have already deleted about 100 of these, and the rest will be done over the course of the next week.		
• When a League Registered Player reaches their 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday, it will flag up an action on the relevant club's Play Cricket Action Centre page that a photo is required for the named player. It will also flag this up on the League Administrator's Action Centre page for the League to monitor and chase clubs up as necessary.	Ongoing
